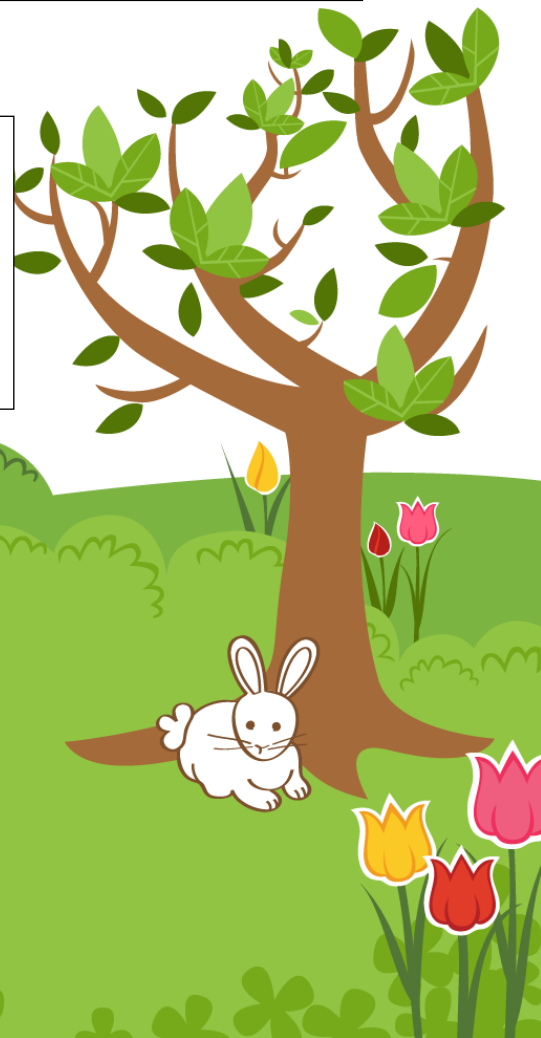

All cities across Minnesota face Road Restrictions this time of year. For LSCB residents, that means trucks weighing no more than 5 tons per axel may drive on our City roads.

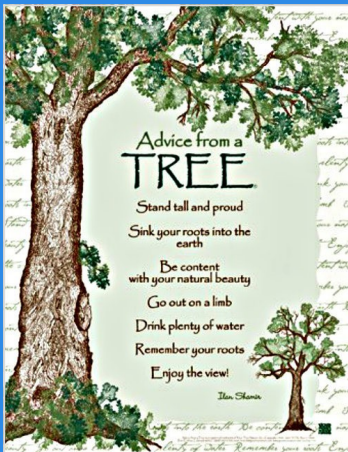
Weight restrictions typically last for eight weeks, unless extraordinary conditions require extending them.

Effective with the March City Council meeting, all LSCB meetings will be held electronically and telephonically via Zoom. Highlights of the March 15, 2021 CC

- ◆ The 2020 LSCB Audit Report and Total Claims in the amount of \$76,425.05 were approved as presented..
- ◆ City Engineer John Parotti, along with Chad Jorgensen from SEH, presented a Speed Limit Study Report that provided engineering analysis so that the City of Lake St. Croix Beach can select a speed limit appropriate on the City's roadways.
- ◆ Potential Street Projects for 2021 were discussed.
- ◆ Ownership at 2020 St. Croix Trail South was transferred to IYS Ventures LLC d/b/a I Mart Stores.
- ◆ A grant has been applied for to assist our Community in managing ash trees for emerald ash borer (EAB).

Pet Owners

Be a courteous pet owner. Make sure you clean-up after your dog when you are out walking in the City parks and along the street. Carry a plastic bag with you to pickup waste and take it home with you.

All Animals Must Be Leashed

The Animal Control Officer can pick up dogs and cats running at large. If the animal is licensed, every effort will be made to return the animal to its owner. If the animal is unlicensed, it will be taken to the St. Croix Animal Shelter and held until the owner has paid all City and shelter fees.

The City's Animal Control Officer also handles all barking dogs or other nuisance complaints. For additional information, call the City Hall at 651.436.7031.

Watch for Children

Care should be taken to watch for children on bikes and people walking. Drive slowly through neighborhoods and please observe the stop signs at designated intersections.

Be Safe – Be Seen!

There is danger in the dark – the biggest being vehicles that don't expect you or can't see you. Wearing reflective clothing is a good defense against invisibility, but you need to be sure the reflective areas are large enough and are exposed from every angle.

Ordinance 724.04 Outdoor Implements . . . any power lawn mower, snowblower, power hedge clipper, power saw, or such other implement designed primarily for outdoor use, shall be operated only between the hours of 7:30 a.m. to 9:00 p.m. on weekdays, or between the hours of 9:00 a.m. to 9:30 p.m. on Saturdays, Sundays, and State and Federal Holidays.

Between November and April, no vehicle can be left parked on the streets of the City for more than 24 consecutive hours at any time.



Summer Parking Restrictions

On-street parking is prohibited between 10:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m. May 1 through September 30 on the east side of County Road 18 and where posted "No Parking."

License Your Pet

Licensing is one of the most important things you can do to keep your pet safe. Unfortunately, it is also one of the most overlooked ordinances by city residents.

All cats and dogs over 4 months of age are required to be licensed, display a city issued collar tag, and have a **valid rabies vaccination.**

Lifetime pet license fees are \$10 for spayed/neutered pets and \$25 for pets that are not.
