Highlights of the June 20, 2022 City Council Meeting

A total of 46 incidents were reported from Washington County Sheriff's Department in May 2022 - with 5 citations issued; Lower St. Croix Valley reported 10 calls for the month of May - 42 year to date.

Significant Receipts for April 2022 were \$850 for Pettitt Park Banner Fees. Significant Expenses include \$17,860 to Lower St. Croix Valley Fire Department for 2nd quarter fire protection services, \$4,777.59 for engineering fees for the bluffland, and \$47,435 to Fischer Company for the City Hall Roof down payment.

The City was notified of funding available through the Middle St. Croix Watershed Management Organization [WMO], with motion passed to authorize the City Engineer to communicate the City's interest for funds to complete the bluff toe reinforcement project. This project would provide water quality benefits to the St. Croix River and qualifies for the remaining funds and would come from the same source as the Riviera Avenue water quality project already approved by the City.

After receiving a recommendation from the Planning Commission, Ordinance 2022-02, an interim ordinance placing a temporary moratorium on new establishment, permitting, or licensing of short term rentals in the City and directing a study to be conducted was adopted and in effective for a period of twelve (12) months.

A contract to provide security service at Riverfront Beach by Blue Line Investigations & Security Services, LLC was approved to be used in conjunction with security service provided by Washington County Sheriff's Department.

A Resolution was adopted appointing election judges for the August 9, 2022 Primary and November 8, 2022 General Elections.

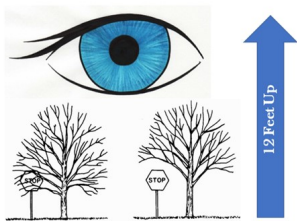

The City receives a number of complaints concerning trees and hedges growing over lane ways, obstructing street signs, and interfering with sight lines at intersections.

Please trim your trees and shrubs back at least 5 feet from the road and 12 feet up. This is especially important at 4-way intersections.

The goal is to ensure all rental properties are properly maintained and comply with State and local building and zoning codes, and fire codes, by conducting onsite inspections.

Any portion of a single-family dwelling or accessory apartment rented to and occupied by someone other than family members of the owner of the principal structure is required to obtain a license for a Residential Rental Property.
