Summer has arrived and will be officially here on June 21. The good news is that our Swimming Beach is officially open.

2022 Beach Parking Passes are available for residents of Lake St. Croix Beach only and can be purchased at City Hall. Cost is \$10 for the 2022 season. If you are 65 years of age or older, you can get a beach parking pass for free.

The Beach Pavilion at Riverfront Park is also ready for use. This is a great location and facility for your summer gathering with the playground, beach, restrooms, changing area, grills, and tables available. Reservations can be made through City Hall to use the pavilion for your event.

Highlights of the May 16, 2022 City Council Meeting

A total of 19 incidents were reported from Washington County Sheriff's Department in April 2022, with 2 citations issued; Lower St. Croix Valley reported 6 calls for the month of April, 32 year to date.

Significant Receipts for March 2022 were \$900 for newsletter ads and \$4,825 for watercraft permits. Significant Expenses include \$10,544 for Insurance—Workman's Comp, Property, and Liability and \$6,358 for Stairway/Street Engineering.



The Planning Commission requested Council's feedback into reinstating investigation into short term rentals, specifically Airbnb rentals. Discussion was held and consensus reached that the issue should be looked into further by the Planning Commission. The City is presently requiring a Residential Rental Property License for any portion of a single-family dwelling or accessory apartment rented to and occupied by someone other than family members of the owner of the principal structure.

City Engineer John Parotti reported the 2021 Streets Project has resumed and is near completion; they are currently seeding to germinate and his recommendation is to let the seed germinate and come back in June for any other repair. They will be marking the pavement striping and will do the actual striping in a couple of weeks.

Security at the beach was discussed with possibility of a private security company hired in conjunction with deputy coverage with the Washington County Sheriff's Department

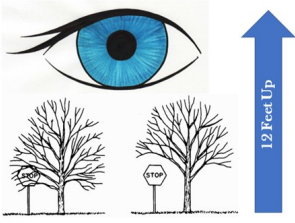

Please trim your trees and shrubs back at least 5 feet from the road and 12 feet up. This is especially important at 4-way intersections.

RENTAL HOUSING PROPERTY—The City of Lake St. Croix Beach requires all rental housing property to be licensed to protect the health, safety, and welfare of its residents. The goal is to ensure all rental properties are properly maintained and comply with State and local building and zoning codes, and fire codes, by conducting onsite inspections.



Any portion of a single-family dwelling or accessory apartment rented to and occupied by someone other than family members of the owner of the principal structure are required to obtain a license for a Residential Rental Property.

Letters have recently been sent to non-homesteaded properties in the City along with a LSCB Rental License Application and LSCVFD Evaluation Affidavit. If you have a rental property and did not receive an application, please contact City Hall at 651.436.7031.
